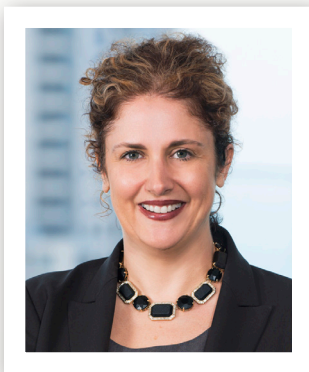


Walk the Walk: Diversity And Inclusion In The Legal Profession
